Eladio Fernández, *Hispaniola: A Photographic Journey through Island Biodiversity*, with a foreword by E.O. Wilson (Cambridge, MA: Harvard University Press, 2007). A beautiful, coffee-table presentation of the island's plants and animals, with helpful surveys on Hispaniolan ecology, presented in both English and Spanish.

Steven Latta et al., *Birds of the Dominican Republic and Haiti*, Princeton Field Guides (Princeton, NJ: Princeton University Press, 2006). The first comprehensive field guide to the birds of Hispaniola.
